Manifesto commitment to ban trophy hunting imports

I was honoured to represent the Government's manifesto commitment to ban trophy hunting imports with the Hunting Trophies (Import Prohibition) Bill. Furthermore, on 30th March I was delighted to announce Baroness Fookes as the House of Lords sponsor.

I would firstly like to thank the outstanding support I have received from Government and parliamentary colleagues in both House of Commons and the House of Lords, and we express our gratitude to the civil servants from the Department for Environment, Food & Rural Affairs.

Sadly, I am gravely concerned that the passage of the Bill was hindered in the House of Lords. This included approximately 48 days when the Lords sponsor, Baroness Fookes, was prevented from taking her role due to discourteous tactics of a minority of Peers. I thus also take this opportunity to publicly thank Baroness Fookes for her fortitude and resolve through a most difficult time.

The Bill had outstanding cross-party support from Conservative, Labour, Liberal Democrat, SNP, DUP, Plaid Cymru, SDLP, Independent and Green Party MPs and Peers. Parliament has been repeatedly assured that the Bill had Government support. Additionally I wish to thank Rt Hon John Spellar MP for his sponsorship of the Hunting Trophies (Import Prohibition) (No. 2) Bill, which was withdrawn on 17th March upon my Bill passing House of Commons third reading and moving to the House of Lords.

We respectfully ask you to honour this manifesto commitment and bring forward a Government Bill to ban trophy hunting imports without further delay.

On 14th October 2019, HM the Queen presented the Most Gracious Speech to both Houses of Parliament stating, *'Proposals will also be brought forward to promote and protect the welfare of animals, including banning imports from trophy hunting.'*

This commitment in the Queen's Speech to ban trophy hunting imports was widely welcomed and followed the contribution of our late colleague, Sir David Amess, in a parliamentary debate on banning trophy hunting imports only two weeks earlier.

In that debate Sir David said, 'Trophy hunting is a wicked, evil practice, and anyone who indulges in it or encourages it should be absolutely ashamed of themselves. We should not mince words or be intimidated on this issue: trophy hunting is an absolutely disgusting practice.'

We concur with the sentiment and views expressed by Sir David and note that every measure of public opinion that has been taken shows that the British people overwhelmingly want a ban on trophy hunting imports.

You have given a public commitment on banning trophy hunting imports. We urge you to implement the ban as quickly as possible in memory of those who are no longer with us.

Since the 2019 General Election manifesto commitment was made, there have been many representations to yourself from figures such as Dame Jane Goodall, Sir Ranulph Fiennes and most recently, Peter Egan, Ricky Gervais and Dame Joanna Lumley.

We support the view of the **Coalition Against Trophy and Canned Hunting (CATCH)** on the need to implement a ban on the importation of hunting trophies.

The CATCH coalition include animal charities organisations and individuals: Action for Primates, Animal Defenders International, Animal Interfaith Alliance, Born Free Foundation, Campaign to Ban Trophy Hunting, Catholic Concern for Animals, Conservative Animal Welfare Foundation, Four Paws, Humane Society International, International Wildlife Bond, Labour Animal Welfare Society, Lion Aid, OneKind, People for Nature and Peace, Protecting African Lions, Quaker Concern for Animals, RSPCA, Voice4Lions, Wildlife and Conservation Foundation, World Animal Protection, Zimbabwe Elephant Foundation, Dame Jane Goodall and Sir Ranulph Fiennes.

We hope you will agree that the Government should announce its intention to Parliament and the country so that the promise to the people can be fulfilled and we can end the importation of 'trophies' including lion paws and heads, and elephant feet, tusks and skin as soon as possible.

We would therefore ask you to make an announcement without further delay. We hope that you will uphold your previously stated desire to see an end to the importation of animal parts derived from trophy hunting into the UK.

We look forward to your urgent response.
